In line with the values of British Triathlon, Portsmouth Triathletes believe the triathlon community has a responsibility to care for and protect the environment in which we operate.

We are committed to reducing our environmental impact and continually improving our environmental performance as an integral and fundamental part of our club strategy and operating methods.

It is our priority to encourage our members, partners, race entrants and all business associates to do the same.

Our policy is to

- Adopt the highest environmental standards in all areas of our operation, complying with or exceeding the requirements of current environmental legislation and codes of practice
- Minimise energy and water usage at our training sessions, social events and races
- Minimise our waste through careful and efficient use of all materials and energy, and reuse or recycle as much as possible
- Minimise the use of vehicles and processes we use in order to conserve supplies, encouraging the use of alternative means of transport and car sharing as appropriate
- Operate our events and activities with due regard to environmental issues as far as reasonably practical
- Consider the potential for air, water, noise and light pollution at our events and aim to reduce any impacts from our operations on the environment and the local community
- Reduce risks from environmental, health or safety hazards for those taking part in or in the vicinity of our events
- Purchase sustainable products and services that do the least damage to the environment wherever possible (e.g. recycled, Fair Trade, FSC or low environmental impact products and energy from renewable sources) and encourage others to do the same
- Assess the environmental impact of any new processes or products we intend to introduce in advance
